

Playdough recipe to develop fine motor skills.

Makes 1 coloured ball

Prep 10 minutes

You will need

- 8 tbsp plain flour
- 2 tbsp table salt-
- 60ml warm water
- food colouring
- 1 tbsp vegetable oil


Method

1. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. In a separate bowl mix together the water, a few drops of food colouring and the oil.
2. Pour the coloured water into the flour mix and bring together with a spoon.
3. Dust a work surface with a little flour and turn out the dough. Knead together for a few minutes to form a smooth, pliable dough. If you want a more intense colour you can work in a few extra drops of food colouring.
4. Store in a plastic sandwich bag (squeeze out the air) in the fridge to keep it fresh. You can make a batch of colours and give away as kids' party bag favours or hold a playdough party for your child's next birthday.



Diary Writing


Can you keep a diary and draw pictures of the activities that you get up to at home!

E.g. $2 + 2 = 4$ Can you practise subtraction using objects and write the number equation E.g. $4 - 2 = 2$ Keep practising halving and doubling numbers to 20.
