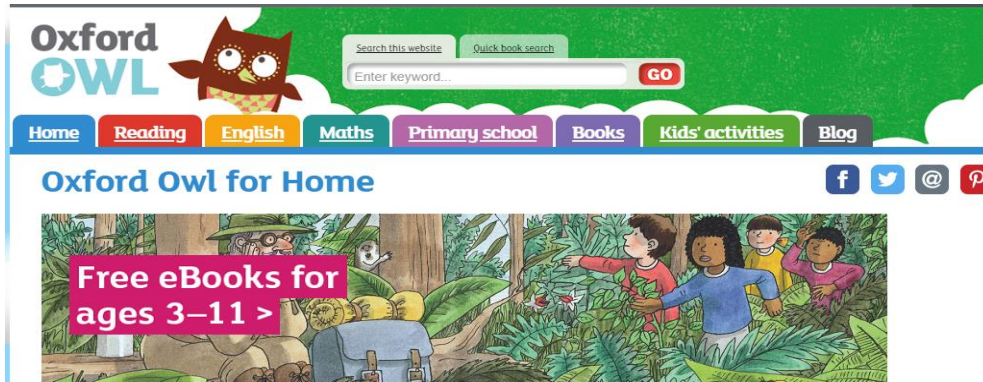


Reading

It is important that you attempt to read with your child daily and **recap all Phase 2 and 3 sounds** to keep these fresh in their minds. We have uploaded **phonics mats** with these sounds on to support you.
