Remote Learning Expectations

5th January 2021

Dear Parents,

Following the announcement last night to move education to remote learning until February half-term, we have put together guidance on what to expect from school and what we expect from the children who are accessing their learning remotely.

What to expect from school:

As a school, we will endeavour to ensure that learning is appropriately differentiated and tailored to meet the needs of all children so that they can access it. Where possible, we will try to ensure that the remote learning on offer is comparable to a 'normal' school day. This will consist of daily lessons for English, Maths and Topic (an area of the wider curriculum). Clear instructions will be provided for each task and video demonstrations (where necessary). Once learning has been completed, teaching staff will then provide feedback as soon as is conveniently possible.

Every morning, English and Maths learning will be uploaded onto the **Class Dojo** (<https://www.classdojo.com>) platform by 9:30am. Topic learning will then be uploaded for the afternoon.

All children are expected to attend their daily ZOOM call. The meeting joining code and time will be shared with parents via a text message and will remain the same for each meeting. This call is an important part of the day where the teacher will be available to provide support, feedback and answer any questions in order to ensure your child can access their learning.

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If your child is unable to access their learning on Class Dojo because you do not have access to a suitable electronic device, school has access to 59 laptops which have been prioritised for older children (who will be required to complete more word processing). As we only have a limited supply of laptops, hard copies are also available for those with no other means of accessing their learning. We will be investigating the possibility of procuring more devices throughout the lockdown period.

What we expect from the children:

We recognise and appreciate that for some children, completing remote learning will be challenging. If this is the case, please contact school and we will try our utmost to help support you. In addition, we also appreciate that remote learning may be completed at a time which is convenient for yourself, should the school hours conflict with your normal working day. We completely understand that this current situation presents us with plenty of challenges which we must try to overcome in order to minimise the disruption to your child's education.

Nevertheless, we expect that all children will try their best to complete their learning every day. It has now been written into law that all schools must provide remote learning and we are expected to robustly monitor their engagement throughout the week.
