CRITICAL WORKERS' CHILDREN AND THOSE CONSIDERED VULNERABLE

Dear Parents/Carers,

It is great to hear that you are sending your children back to school. We look forward to seeing you. Please be aware of the following:

- Your child will need to be dropped off **at their usual time in the same yard** they have been dropped off at all year so far. Collection times and places are the same as well.
- All children should wear uniform as usual.
- Children will be in new year group bubbles, rather than classes, they will not be mixing across year groups and will be with children their own age.
- The class teachers will be there to greet you and the children as normal and will answer any of your questions. It might not always be your child's class teacher, however, it will be a class teacher and teaching assistant from their year group. Sometimes their own class teacher will be providing remote learning for the rest of the year group and will not be available for face to face teaching.
- Please only one parent to accompany children on to the site at any time.
- Children walking to and from school by themselves must be reminded not to mix with children from other groups.
- Please do not bring anything in from home except coats and lunch bags. Mobile phones must be given to the adult leading your child's group who will return them at the end of the day.
- The school day will be the same as it is usually, with formal lessons delivered by class teachers and staggered breaks and lunch times. **School meals will be operating as usual, including hot meals and free school meals.**
- It is an expectation that children will attend school all day, every day, Monday to Friday, unless they are ill and unable to attend or isolating following instruction from Test and Trace. School cannot operate a part-time system for children during this lockdown due to the increased demand for places. Should you wish for your child to stop attending face-to-face learning during the lockdown and take up remote learning instead, this is your choice, attendance at this time is not mandatory. Please call the school office to notify us of this decision.
