## Free School Meals Vouchers for Christmas

Every Free School Meals eligible child (means tested not universal infant FSM) will receive a £35 voucher for the two-week Christmas holiday period. This is made up of £15 per week to cover food and £5 per child towards energy costs. All children who are currently eligible for FSM and registered for FSM up to 24<sup>th</sup> December will be eligible to benefit from this scheme. The council aim to have the voucher letters distributed to parents this week.

You need to go to the following website to redeem the Christmas vouchers [www.selectyourcompliment.co.uk/grocery](http://www.selectyourcompliment.co.uk/grocery) (please note the difference between this and the website for the October half term vouchers which didn't have the "/grocery" element in the address. Parents must continue to use the previous address for the October half term vouchers if you are yet to redeem this one.)

- Enter their unique 16-digit eCode and select your chosen supermarket
- The downloaded E-Gift Card/Voucher will arrive by email within 24 hours. If you can't find this, check your Junk/Spam folder
- The FSM Voucher helpline will be available on 0114 2734567 and can offer help to anybody experiencing difficulties with their eCodes or with general FSM enquiries.

## Christmas Parties and Productions
